The library's contemporary music performances have been popular and this month we **welcome rock and blues music legends Steve Lucas and Chris Wilson**. Lead vocalist, guitarist and producer, **Steve has been involved in the music industry since 1977**, playing with bands such as X, Bigger than Jesus, Double Cross and Neon & Venom. He's toured in Australia and overseas and supported Iggy Pop, The Cramps, the Damned, and the Stranglers.



He's joined by legendary blues musician Chris Wilson who is an essential part of blues and rock music in Australia since taking the stage with the Sole Twisters twenty years ago. Stints with Harum Scarum and Paul Kelly and the Coloured Girls followed, and the end of the 80s saw Wilson as one of our finest vocalists, harmonica players and songwriters, fronting the superb Crown of Thorns.

Together, Steve and Chris will sing and talk about their music influences and how Melbourne's music scene has shaped their music careers.
