Report of the Committee of Management

OF THE

MELBOURNE

MECHANICS' INSTITUTION AND SCHOOL OF ARTS,
FOR THE YEAR 1867.

1. THE Committee of Management of the Melbourne Mechanics' Institution have the honour to present to the members their annual report, with the audited balance sheet and statement of liabilities, by which it will be seen that the finances are in a satisfactory condition.
2. The indispensable repairs to the building which were ordered by the last annual meeting have been effected, at a cost exceeding the estimate by £57 3s. and the whole of the building, with the exception of the secretary's office, is in a thorough state of repair. The vestibule and staircase, reading-room and hall, have been painted and papered, and the library also repainted.
3. The Committee estimated the gross revenue for the year 1867 at £1000, an estimate, it will be observed, which was only in excess of the actual receipts (deducting a loan of £150 obtained from the bank by the trustees) by the sum of £8 13s 11d; one-half of the loan has been repaid to the bank, and there are funds in hand collected since the audit, 31st December, sufficient to pay off the balance, which will accordingly be done.
4. This satisfactory state of the finances, and the assiduity of the assistant librarian, appeared to the Committee to warrant an increase of his salary, which was accordingly raised to the sum of £100 per annum, on the first day of March last.
5. The number of new books purchased during the past year (1867) was 124 volumes, and ninety-three volumes of periodicals, making a total of 217 volumes. The very few works of sterling merit published during the year was the cause of the Committee not making a larger addition to the Library.
6. The number of members on the annual roll of subscribers

for 1867 was 437 ; that of new members, 117 ; the number of Life Members was 118 ; and of Honorary Members, 18.

10. Instructions have been given for the preparation of a Supplementary Catalogue to the end of 1867 of all the books added to the Library since 1864 (the date of the general catalogue), which will be in the hands of the printer in a short time.

11. The Committee would point out that in the item £139 6s 6d, there is a sum of £94 6s 6d, which is a balance remaining due of the £207 expended on the repairs and renovation of the Institution, the benefits of which expenditure extend over following years. There is £82 2s 4d, now in the bank, collected since the date of the audit, and there is every reason to rely on the stability of the financial state of the Institution.
