REPORT RE ALTERATIONS.

The Sub-Committee, which has been enquiring into the questions of appointing a Caretaker, and of providing a Smoking Room, etc., has gone carefully into the matters, and now recommends as follows:-

CARETAKER.

That the position of Caretaker be advertised for, and that the arrangements for the Staff be as follow:

(a) Caretaker to be on duty from 7 a.m. to 9.30 a.m. and from 5 p.m. to 11 p.m. daily; from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. on Sundays; and from 6.15 p.m. to 9 p.m. on alternate Sundays. Salary £2 per week.

The Caretaker would open the building at 7 a.m., and complete the cleaning, leaving the lad instructions as to his duties, at 9.30 a.m. He would renume at 5 p.m. and during the evening would be in charge of the Reading Room etc., and before leaving at 11 p.m. would see that the building was properly locked up. It is proposed that the Caretaker should wear a cap and badge to indicate his position.

(b) Assistant to be on duty from 11 p.m. to 7 a.m. nightly, and from 6.15 p.m. to 9 p.m. on alternate Sundays. Salary, £1/15/per week.

The Assistant would do the greater part of the cleaning necessary, during the night, and would also be a watchman. To ensure his attention, special direct telephone communication with the Fire Brigade Station could be established at a cost of £3/6/per annum. He would then be required to ring up the Fire Station hourly between 11 p.m. and 7 a.m.

(c) Lad to be on duty from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. (with interval of an hour for lunch). Salary, 10/- per week.

SMOKING ROOM.

The Committee has had plans prepared, for alterations to the building, to provide a Smoking Room. These plans will be presented to the Meeting on Friday. They provide for a Smoking Room over the present Secretary's Office (24ft.16in. x 12ft.), and taking in one flat of the Cafetaker's quarters (20ft x 10ft.6in.) This would provide a fine room, and special lighting and ventilating arrangements would also be provided. The room would be practically on the same level as the present Reading Room, being reached by a short

flight of four steps. The present lavatory and urinal outside the reading room would be demolished, and built out from the north end of the new smoking room, thus removing what is now a source of annoyance and discomfort.

The present Secretary's Office would be increased in size, (though reduced in height to 8 feet) to the same area as the new Smoking Room, and would be much more useful and commodious than the present room.

These alterations would do away with portion of the Caretaker's quarters, but provision is made in the plans, for alterations which will make the lower rooms more habitable, if required, than they have hitherto been.

MUSIC ROOM.

The alterations involved in the making of a Smoking Room, will necessitate the abolition of the room over the Secretary's Office, hitherto used by Mr. Johnstone at a rental of £26 per annum. The Committee recommends that the room on the right hand side of the main entrance, should be put in order, and thoroughly cleaned and ventilated. Mr. Johnstone is willing to take this room on lease for five years at a rental of £40 per annum and to pay for electric light used, and electric power required to run ventilation motor. He also proposes option of renewal for further term of 5 years at a rental of £45 per annum.

GENERAL.

The General Committee has already agreed to the proposal to ventilate the front shops, east of the main entrance, and to consider the proposal to ventilate and renovate the Reading Room, in conjunction with the Smoking Room proposals.
